How to Change Your State Benefit Plan Selections to Support Life Events

University of Illinois System employees are only allowed to make changes to their State of Illinois benefit plans during the annual Benefit Choice period or when they experience a qualifying life event, such as the birth of a child.

Changes to any State of Illinois plan must be submitted within 60 calendar days of the date of the event.

Examples of Qualifying Events Are:

- Marriage or Civil Union
 - Birth of a child or adoption

What Documentation Do You Need to Provide?

- Marriage/Civil Union Certificate
- Birth Certificate
- Divorce Decree
